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Grinstein's research explores corporate financial and governance decisions, as well as the impact of financial regulations on firms. His work has been published in leading academic journals, including *The Journal of Finance*, *The Journal of Financial Economics*, *Management Science*, and *Oxford Review of Economic Policy*, among others. Grinstein is a member of the European Corporate Governance Institute. Between the years 2006-2007 he served as a visiting academic scholar at the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.
