

The Student Exchange Program

The Office of Global Engagement is pleased to bring to your attention the Student Exchange Program opportunities for Semester A of the 2026-2027 Academic Year.

Under this program, Reichman University students will enroll for one semester abroad at select universities around the world, while a group of students from these universities will similarly study at Reichman University for a semester.

For Reichman University students, the exchange offers a once in a lifetime opportunity to live and study in various institutions around the world, as well as participate in a wide array of events and extra-curricular activities at the hosting country.

There is no doubt that participating in a student exchange involves special effort. We urge you to endeavor to experience something that is extraordinary – not just for academic experience, but a personal and cultural one as well.

Target Audience:

Second or third-year Students from all Schools are welcome to apply for the program, subject to successfully completing the criteria specified below:

Selection criteria:

Necessary conditions to apply for these programs include:

- ✚ A GPA of 80 and above
- ✚ No previous disciplinary record at Reichman University
- ✚ Successful completion of “Advanced English B” is mandatory before applying

After screening all applications, applicants may be invited for a personal interview.

*** Please note, a letter of acceptance from Reichman University does NOT mean you have been accepted to the host university!*

Timing:

*Reichman University students can only go out on exchange during the **Fall semester**.*

The semester abroad will replace the academic semester at Reichman University. Many institutions abroad start in the beginning of August and last through the end of December.

Coursework:

Reichman University students can enroll for credit in courses available for exchange students, subject to prerequisites, capacity limitations and availability at the host institutions. Reichman University students will get credit for all courses they complete successfully abroad, subject to approval by their academic advisor and coordinator.

*** For all course related questions, you must contact your academic coordinator.*

Tuition:

Reichman University students will continue to pay regular tuition at Reichman, while tuition payment at the host institution is waived for exchange students (excluding Berkeley program which is not an exchange thus includes tuition).

*** Tuition payment for students who have completed their studies is waived both at Reichman University and at the university abroad.*

Accommodations:

Reichman University students will receive some information and guidance in finding proper housing, but exchange students are responsible for their own housing arrangements abroad.

Financial Responsibility:

*Exchange students will be responsible for their **own expenses** abroad, including travel, accommodation, health insurance and all other living costs.*

*** Please pay careful attention to the high living expenses and extra university fees in the USA.*

Please bear in mind the following:

- Reichman University students can only go out on exchange during the Fall semester.
- When selecting 3 institutions on your application, due to the number of spots and your academic standing, it could very well happen that you will be accepted to your 2nd or 3rd choice and in some cases, it may happen that you are not accepted to all three.
- If you are interested in applying for exchange at one of the South/Central American partner universities, please note their extremely early semester start date of late July/early August. The early semester dates could coincide with possible Moed A or B exams at Reichman University.
