Please note that the price in USD of all degrees originally billed in NIS varies according to fluctuation in exchange rates.

Housing costs are based on RU dorms.

Board includes food.

Books and Supplies include paper, printing, books, notebook, pens, photocopies and other supplies necessary for the student's studies.

Personal expenses include leisure activities, loan fees, utilities, Student Union fee (\$60), any external insurance fees, etc.

Note that personal expenses are estimated higher during students' first year of study when initial supplies and/or furnishings are purchased for the duration of studies.

Please note that you cannot do an internship/externship for academic credit if you are a FAFSA loan borrower nor be enrolled in a degree with an internship/externship requirement.
