

Application and Admissions Regulations Graduate Degrees 2026-2027

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1. **Application Period**

Regular Application: November 15, 2025 – July 31, 2026

Late Application for applicants who don't need pre-requisite: until August 31, 2026

All forms and documents must be submitted to the Raphael Recanati International School Admissions Office by July 31, 2026 (applicants who don't need pre-requisite courses need to submit all required documents by August 31, 2026). Applications will not be reviewed or considered until all required documents are submitted.

Applications are reviewed based on availability, and admission will be subject to compliance with the admissions requirements as well as the approval of the Admissions Committee. The number of available spots in the graduate degrees are limited, and Reichman University reserves the right

to impose stricter criteria on applicants who apply during the late application period or on applicants who submit any required information, transcripts, or documents during that period.

2. Registration Fee

The Registration fee is 300 NIS, to be paid via the Online Registration Form and is non-refundable.

3. RRIS Graduate Programs

The Raphael Recanati International School offers the following graduate programs taught in English:

- Please note that it is **not** possible to apply to more than one program at a time. When applying, a candidate is applying to a specific degree program and not to the Raphael Recanati International School as a whole.
 - There are several programs within each of Reichman University Schools and their admissions criteria may differ.
 - Students who decide to apply to a program after they have already applied for a different one, are required to notify the admissions coordinator in writing. Admission will be based on availability and the admissions criteria for that program.

4. Academic Requirements

One Year MBA

- Completed undergraduate degree with a GPA of 85% (3.3) or above from a recognized academic institution
- Applicants with a BA in engineering need a GPA of 80% (3.0) or above
- Applicants with a GPA below the requirement can present a GMAT score of at least 47 in the quantitative field.
- The One Year MBA does not require previous work experience.
- Applicants who come from a non-quantitative degree will be required to take prerequisite courses in Mathematics, Statistics and Microeconomics.

Global MBA

- The Global MBA requires at least three to five years of professional work experience following BA completion.
- Completed undergraduate degree with a GPA of 80% (3.0) or above from a recognized academic institution
- Applicants with a GPA below 80% can present a GMAT score of at least 47 in the quantitative field.
- Applicants who come from a non-quantitative degree will be required to take prerequisite courses in Mathematics, Statistics and Microeconomics.

MBA in Healthcare Innovation

- The MBA in Healthcare Innovation requires at least three years of professional work experience in the Healthcare field following BA completion.
- Completed undergraduate degree with a GPA of 80% (3.0) or above from a recognized academic institution
- Applicants with a GPA below 80% can present a GMAT score of at least 47 in the quantitative field.
- Applicants who come from a non-quantitative degree will be required to take prerequisite courses in Mathematics, Statistics and Microeconomics.

MA in Financial Economics

- Completed undergraduate degree with a GPA of 80% (3.0) or above from a recognized academic institution
- Applicants must have a strong quantitative background with at least two semester-long courses in Statistics and Calculus from their undergraduate degree.
- Preference will be given to applicants with undergraduate degrees in Computer Science, Economics, Business, Exact Sciences and Engineering.
- Prerequisite courses in Mathematics and Economics are provided right before the program starts and are required for full acceptance.

MSc in Machine Learning & Data Science

- Completed BA or BSc degree with a GPA of 90% (3.7) or above from a recognized academic institution.
- Applicants with a BSc in Computer Science need a GPA of 85% or above.
- Non-Computer Science students will be required to take the following 3 prerequisite courses: Introduction to Computer Science and Programming in Python; Data Structures Algorithms and Complexity; Introduction to Operating Systems and Databases.
- Students with an insufficient quantitative background will be required to complete the following prerequisite courses: Linear Algebra for Data Science; Calculus A/B; Probability Theory.

MA in Human-Computer Interaction (HCI)

- Completed undergraduate degree with a GPA of 82% (3.15) or above from a recognized academic institution in a relevant field (partial list of relevant fields: communications, computer science, engineering, psychology, design, art, media, architecture, information systems)
- In exceptional cases, students who don't meet this requirement can be accepted based on their portfolio or professional experience.
- The following prerequisite courses are required: Introduction to Computing Principles (waived for students with a BSc); Introduction to Applied Research Methods (waived for students with a Psychology degree); Introduction to Visual Design (waived for students with a Design degree); Introduction to Human-Computer Interaction (waived for students with an Interactive Communications degree)

MA in Government

- Completed undergraduate degree with a GPA of 80% (3.0) or above from a recognized academic institution
- Applicants for the specialization with thesis need a GPA of 88% or above from the undergraduate degree.
- Prerequisite courses in International Relations, International Politics and Research Methods may be required.

MA in Behavioral Economics

- Completed Undergraduate degree from a recognized academic institution.
- Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or 80% and above.
- Interview either in person or online.
- Personal statement stating your expectations from the program, why you are interested in the program, and your professional career goals as they relate to the program.

- Students who do not have any background in quantitative fields will be required to take preparatory courses (Mathematics, Microeconomics, and Statistics)
- Students who do not have any background in psychology will be required to take introduction to Psychology
- Professional proficiency in English (written and spoken)

5. Required Documents

When applying to one of the RRIS graduate programs, all applicants must submit the following:

1. A scanned copy of an Israeli ID card or an international passport

2. Undergraduate Transcript

Applicants must submit official transcripts of previous academic undergraduate and graduate studies. Applicants in their final year of studies may submit partial transcripts. Acceptance of these applicants is contingent upon receipt of final transcripts that show they graduated their BA and that their final grades are similar to those earned in previous semesters.

An official, notarized English translation must be submitted for all transcripts not originally issued in English.

3. Undergraduate Diploma

Applicants must submit an official copy of their undergraduate diploma. Applicants in their final year of studies may apply without a diploma. Acceptance of these applicants is contingent upon receipt of an official copy of the diploma / diploma eligibility before the beginning of the academic school year.

4. Curriculum Vitae (CV)/Resume

Applicants must submit a CV (in English) detailing their educational and professional history. Please make sure your full name is at the top of your CV and that it is in professional CV format.

5. English Proficiency Exam

The academic curriculum of the Raphael Recanati International School is taught entirely in English. If English was not the primary language of instruction in the applicant's undergraduate degree, they are required to pass an English Proficiency Exam. All applicants must prove their English language proficiency validated through a TOEFL (above 90), IELTS (above 6.5), or AMIRAM (above 120). Applicants who studied their BA in Israel, are exempt from the English proficiency exam.

 - Personal Statement: One page explaining applicant's background, interest in the program and aspirations.
 - For the thesis track a two-page personal statement highlighting academic background, research interests, and professional aspiration is required. THIS IS WRONG-should be: For the Thesis track, a 10-15 page research paper written by the applicant, on any subject, is required in English or Hebrew.
- **MA in Human-Technology Interaction (HCI)**
 - Admissions Survey
 - Completed table of Reference Contact details
- **MSc in Machine Learning and Data-Science**
 - A one-page personal statement in English highlighting your background and professional aspirations
 - Completed table of Reference Contact details

Once an application is received and processed by the RRIS Graduate Admissions Office, the candidate will receive an e-mail confirming the receipt of their application. Should any further documents be needed, the candidate will receive a detailed e-mail from the admissions officer listing the documents that must be provided.

Candidates who present non-original transcripts at the time of registration will be evaluated based on the data presented. Original documents need to be presented by the beginning of the academic school year. Candidates who don't present their final original transcripts and diploma by the beginning of the academic school year may get rejected from the program.

6. Admissions Process

The process of admission to graduate studies includes a few steps:

Phase A – Submission of all required documents and completing the candidate's file.

Phase B – The candidate's file is transferred to the admissions committee of the program of choice, who examines the candidacy according to the academic (and professional if required) details.

Phase C – In programs where an admissions interview is required and if the admissions committee decides to invite the candidate to the interview stage, the candidates will come for the interview (either online or in person).

Please note:

- Admission to a program is based on the level of the candidate's achievements.
- The RRIS Admissions Committee reserves the right to grant some preference in admissions decisions.
- It is not possible to apply to more than one program at a time. If a candidate does not meet the threshold of the program to which they are applying, they will be offered other options by the Admissions Officer without the need to reapply.
- Applicants who are accepted must complete the application process, including payment of a tuition deposit, within the specified time limit, following notification of acceptance. Paying the deposit is a commitment to studying at Reichman University in the coming academic year and to complying with the tuition regulations.

7. Deferment of Studies

Applicants who have been accepted to a graduate program can request to postpone the start of their studies for up to two years, after paying the down payment. Applicants who want to freeze need to submit a written request to the admissions office by July 31st. Approval of their request will be subject to the decision of the admissions committee.

In order to unfreeze and begin their studies, applicants need to submit a written notice to the admissions office by May 1st. This notice will ensure a secured spot in the program. If a candidate was accepted on condition of completing prerequisite courses, he will need to complete them until the beginning of the academic school year.

Requests to unfreeze who will be received after May 1st will be reviewed based on availability.

If applicants decide not come study at Reichman University after freezing studies, the down payment will not be refunded.

8. Prerequisite Courses

Some of the graduate programs in the RRIS require prerequisite courses which are designed to teach new students various skills that will be necessary to succeed in their graduate studies and need to be completed prior to the beginning of the academic year and

Which pre-requisite courses an applicant needs to take is determined by the admissions committee of each program on a case-by-case basis. The admissions committee may exempt qualified candidates from the pre-requisite courses.

The fee for the pre-requisite courses is not included in tuition and needs to be added to the down payment (if applicable).

The Admissions Committee reserves the right to cancel acceptance of an applicant who does not complete the preparatory courses with the grade of 70 or above.

The admissions committee of the MSc in Machine Learning may require applicants to enroll in a prep-year prior to beginning their degree to complete the above pre-requisite courses.

Learning disabilities / attention deficit disorders

Reasonable accommodations are provided by Reichman University for students who have been diagnosed with learning disabilities or attention deficit disorder.

Students who want the University to recognize their learning disabilities and be eligible for exam accommodations are required to submit appropriate documents to support their requests.

Students who have completed high school in Israel and did regular Bagrut exams (without special accommodations for new immigrants), even if they are studying in the international program, must do a specific standardized test called מ"ל מאל. By submitting an application, the applicant confirms that they are aware that, should they commence their studies as a student at the University, in order to meet the academic requirements, including participation in classes, completion of assignments, exercises, and examinations, they are expected to obtain and use a properly functioning laptop computer, in accordance with the University's recommendations as published from time to time.

The applicant understands that, if admitted and enrolled as a student at Reichman University, they are expected to bring their laptop to classes and examinations and to ensure that it is in proper working condition and ready for use, including the installation of required updates and software, as instructed by the University during the course of their studies. Upon becoming a student, they will be required to use their personal computer in accordance with the University's guidelines, including those relating to information security, data protection and privacy, copyright, and related matters.

12. Tuition Fees and Terms of Payment for 2026-2027

Down Payment

The down payment is due within **two weeks** from the date of your acceptance letter and is part of the total tuition fee. The down payment can be paid either by credit card, check or wire transfer to Reichman University's bank account. Please see below the payment options.

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Scholarships / Discounts / Other Funding

Should a scholarship, Student Authority (Minhal HaStudentim) grant, or any other form of funding be granted to the student, the student should contact the Tuition Department in order to receive a revised payment plan.

Graduates of Reichman University Undergraduate Programs are entitled to a 10% discount from the total program tuition fees.

Student Union Fee

Regulations and procedures for the cancellation or cessation of studies

A student who has registered to study at Reichman University (RU) and has paid the down payment will be considered a Reichman University student in every respect. If extraordinary personal circumstances arise that prevent a student from fulfilling their commitment to study at Reichman University, the student can cancel their registration by submitting a notification in writing by e-mail and must confirm receipt by the department. In order to avoid any misunderstanding, **telephone conversation will not be considered official notice of cessation of studies. Only a formal notice in writing from the student**, submitted to the Admissions Office as well as the Tuition Department, will be considered valid in this matter.

Reichman University will charge the student partial tuition, at a rate based on the date the notification was received. The exact dates are detailed below for each graduate program separately. The earlier Reichman University is notified, the less the student is charged.

Notification of cancellation, cessation or freezing of studies, at any date, will result in the cancellation of the student's entitlement to a scholarship or discounts, which will be cancelled retroactively according to the guidelines of the specific scholarship or discount.

Only after all of the instructions above are completed and all tuition payments are settled in accordance with the cancellation schedule, will the student's account be closed.
