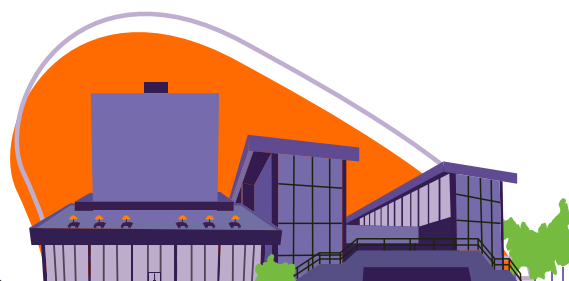

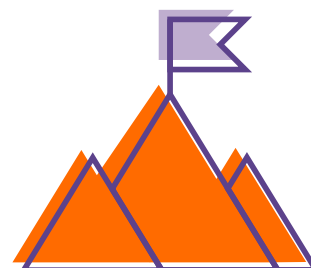

○ **Admission requirements for an Academic Exchange at Anahuac México University:**

- To have a minimum grade of 7.5 (in a 0 to 10 scale) or a minimum GPA of 2.9 or its equivalent in your country scale.
- Not to have failed courses in the moment of the application.
- At least 18 years old.
- To accomplish the language requirements.
- To pass the academic exchange process at your home university.

Application information

1. The home university sends the nomination of each student with the next information:

- Full name
- Home city
- Home university
- Degree: Bachelor or Graduate
- Program the candidate is studying at the home university
- Birth date
- Exchange modality: online or in-class
- Campus to visit: North or South (only for in-class exchanges)
- Exchange term: a semester, full year, summer or trimester (trimesters only for graduate degrees)
- Platform or consortium (only if it applies): ODUICAL, EMOVIES, PROCAI or Alianza del Pacífico
- Student e-mail adress

Only for virtual exchanges:

- List of the courses the student wants to take.

2. After the nomination each student will receive an email with the application link and the responsive letter file.

The student must click on the link, fill the application and upload the following documents:

- Responsive letter
- Valid Passport
- Academic history/Transcript

3. **Admission letters:** Admission letters will be sent by e-mail to the home university coordinator two weeks after we received all of the documents correctly. With this letter, students should apply for a mexican visa when needed.

Exchange fee

An administrative (not academic) \$126 dollars (USD) fee for in-class exchanges or \$33 USD fee for virtual exchanges has to be covered by each visiting student the first week of classes to finish the registration process. All students are expected to cover this fee.

Prices are updated annually in January according to inflation in Mexico

Prices are expresed in USD only as a reference, taking a permanente Exchange Rate of 18.00 Mexican pesos (MXN) per dollar. The payment will be done in Mexican Pesos, in a permanent amount of \$2275 MXN for In-Class exchange and \$590 MXN for virtual exchange.

Language Requirements

- Language proficiency certificate for spanish (mandatory) → minimum B2 level.
- All students must apply a free Spanish test at their arrival to the university and must take a Spanish course during their exchange according to the test results (the course takes 90 total hours per semester).
- The english certificate it's required only when the student wants to take courses taught in English → any certificate with a minimum B2 level equivalent score.

Your students are allowed to apply for

- One semester
- Full academic year
- One trimester or two trimesters (only for graduate degree)
- Summer
- Research stays
- Internship (with previous authorization from the receiving school)
- Medical rotations (only for partners with specific medical rotation agreements)
- 100% online exchanges
- 100% in-class exchanges



Available places

For Traditional Academic Exchange Agreements*:

Each period (semester, summer):

- Two places for South Campus
- Two places for North Campus

*Traditional Academic Exchange: exchanges with academic fee waived places.

If our agreement has a specific number of places, we will give the places according to the agreement. The nominations distribution must be equitable between our two campuses.

Important: If you have more candidates than places, please send the nominations as “EXTRA”. We can receive the extra students in reciprocity according to the availability of spaces on each campus. For these cases Anáhuac México University in Mexico City will choose the campus.

Study Abroad without agreement:

- \$2,900 USD per semester
- \$3,200 USD for Gastronomy and Medicine per semester

Academic load: 18 to 54 academic credits.

Prices are expressed in USD only as a reference, taking a permanente Exchange Rate of 18.00 (MXN) per dollar. The payment will be done in Mexican Pesos, in a permanent amount of \$52,200.00 MXN for any Bachelor and \$59,400.00 MXN for Medicine and Gastronomy.

Study Abroad Agreements:

Nominations distribution must be equitable between our two campus. 20 % discount on Study Abroad fee for universities with Study Abroad agreement.

Consortiums and Associations:

- CONAHEC, SUMA:
The stipulated places on the call for applications on each consortium.
- ODUICAL, PROCAI, EMOVIES, Alianza del Pacífico:
Maximum two students for each campus per university on the consortium with a maximum of 20 students per consortium or association.

Insurance

Each year we check different insurance companies and we choose the one that accomplish better our requirements, the student **MUST** acquire the selected insurance.

We will not accept any other insurance than the one selected by Anahuac Mexico University.

These are the requirements Anahuac Mexico University consider for the selection of the insurance company:

International coverage considering

- Repatriation of mortal remains
- \$60,000 USD coverage for accidental medical expenses
- \$60,000 USD minimum coverage for sickness medical expenses
- Non insurance deductible
- Non coinsurance
- Direct payment in medical attention and hospitalization
- COVID-19 coverage
- Personalized attention for Anahuac Mexico students
- Offices in Mexico
- 24/7 attention

The selected insurance company is communicated to the student on the acceptance letter e-mail.

Insurance coverage is not the insurance cost; insurance coverage refers to the amount of risk or liability that is covered for an individual or entity by way of insurance services.

Immigration Requirements

To travel to Mexico it is necessary to have a valid passport regardless of the term or the reason for the trip, you will need a student visa only in some cases.

Do I need a visa?

You don't need a visa if you accomplish these two requirements:

1. You are a citizen of one of the countries or regions that DO NOT require a visa to travel to Mexico (check the list in the attached link).
2. Your stay in Mexico is less than 180 days.

You need a visa if you accomplish at least one of these conditions:

1. You are a citizen of one of the countries or regions that DO require a visa to travel to Mexico (check the list in the attached link).
2. Your stay in Mexico is longer than 180 days.
