

Computer Labs – Public Computer Stations

There are seven computer labs on campus, with approximately 260 computer stations. When there are no classes in the labs, they are open for students to prepare assignments, learn various software, and print documents. Printing services are available in the labs according to the guidelines detailed in the printing procedures section.

Lab Opening Hours:

- Sunday–Thursday: 08:00–20:00
- Friday: 08:00–14:00

On holiday eves and during vacation periods, a separate notice will be published regarding changes in operating hours.

Regulations for Using Computer Lab Computers:

- A Lab assistant is present in the lab to assist with basic operational issues and provide initial help with various software. Please follow the his instructions.
- Maintain silence in the labs.
- Turn off mobile phones upon entering the labs.
- Keep the lab clean.
- Do not bring any food or drink into the computer labs.
- Do not ask the lab assistant for help with assignments.
- Students who do not know how to use a particular software are invited to contact a teaching assistant during office hours.
- It is recommended to carry your university username and password for efficient use.
- Do not install, change, or download any software or hardware on the computers.

Computers in Lecture Halls

The computers in the lecture halls are intended for use by lecturers only.

Computers in the Library

There are about 25 computers in the library for student use, intended solely for accessing Electronic Resources. These computers are connected to a printer and allow printing of relevant information. They must not be used for other purposes. In case of a malfunction, contact the librarians at the desk for assistance.

Use of Electronic Resources, electronic journals, printouts, and electronic books requires respect for copyright and agreements signed between the library and publishers/suppliers. Access to resources and their use is permitted only to university staff and students, for study and research purposes, and not for commercial use. Improper use of Electronic Resources, including violation of agreements or copyrights, may result in disciplinary action and legal proceedings.

Wireless Network

A wireless network operates on campus, allowing connection to network resources and the internet. In case of a malfunction, contact the IT support team (HelpDesk).

Printing Procedures

Printing is available at public printers on campus, including in the aquarium, labs, and library. Printing is done using a credit card or a copy card purchased at the library. In case of a malfunction, do not touch the printer, contact the Lab assistant/representative or call the phone number listed on the printer. Printing paper is provided on site. University printers print in black and white, single-sided or double-sided. Color printing is available to students only in the library.
