## Priorities were set by the unprecedented decision to support R&D in replacement of crude oil

- The committee held several meetings
- A survey of the energy R&D infrastructure is planned
- A preliminary survey of experts indicated that smart grid, energy efficiency and solar energy are the leading topics
- Survey of energy infrastructure in the academic institutions was given high priority
