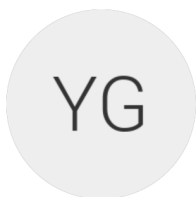

## A [BRIEF] RESEARCH SUMMARY

As a behavioral scientist and social psychology researcher with a focus on emerging technologies, my research endeavors have spanned a wide range of subjects within the *behavioral sciences and sport, technology & performance*. Over the past two decades, my research has spanned several areas, including communications (with a focus on new media and emerging technologies effect) and sport, the sociology and psychology of sport and physical activity, governmental and political aspects of sport and society. Within these research domains, I have explored various topics. I have investigated the psychological and social factors influencing sport performance, examined the symbiotic relationship between media and sports, analyzed the dynamics of gender relations and investigated the influence of politics and nationalism on sports. Additionally, I have examined the intersections of sport with themes such as terrorism, probed into the historical perspectives of sport development in both land and the State of Israel, and explored the realms of physical activity, leisure, ethnicity, violence, and conflict.
