How to Apply

AAU offers rolling admissions, allowing students to apply throughout the year for either the Fall or Spring semester.

In order to apply for an undergraduate (bachelor's) or graduate (master's) program, applicants must submit a completed Application Form (can be submitted online at www.aauni.edu/apply) and all of the documents listed below. The documents can be submitted in English, Czech or Slovak. Documents submitted in any other language not previously stated must be certified by an authorized translator:

Undergraduate Checklist:

- Evidence of completing secondary education (a copy of a High School Diploma or its equivalent, e.g. IB diploma, A levels certificate, etc.)
- Copy of transcript
- Any of the minimum qualifying English test scores: TOEFL (min. 525 on the paper-based test, 71 on Internet-based test); FCE (min. C); CAE (min. 160); IELTS (min. 6 – min. of 5.5 in each subtest); City & Guilds - IESOL (Communicator); IGCSE First Language English (C or above); IGCSE English as a Second Language (B or above); Pearson PTE (min. 76); IB (English A or B at HL/SL) *
- Curriculum Vitae
- Personal statement
- Copy of ID/passport
- Passport size photograph
- For transferring students: transcripts must be sent directly from the original university

Tuition and Fees

At AAU, tuition varies depending on the number of classes registered, the degree you are seeking and any scholarships you may receive. The following prices have been calculated based off an average 5-course semester. BA programs can be completed in 3 years while MA programs can be completed in as little as 2 years.

Scholarships & Financial Aid

AAU is dedicated to ensuring all students are able to start out and continue on the path to a degree—in the 2022/23 academic year alone, the university provided 12.7 million CZK in scholarships, discounts, and other monetary support. Recently, it introduced three new scholarships aimed at helping incoming students financially jump-start their studies: the First-Year Honors Scholarship, the Bilateral Recognition Scholarship, and the External Distinction MA Scholarship. As for current students, they too have an array at their disposal, including the Merit-Based Scholarship, the Accommodation Scholarship, and the Community Engagement Scholarship, among others. The financial aid counselor is on-hand to answer any questions regarding these and other forms of aid the university has to offer.
