The Berkeley Economics Semester Abroad Program, or BESAP, provides international students with the **opportunity to enrich their academic and cultural experience** by spending one to two semesters at the University of California, Berkeley. With BESAP, students must be majoring in Economics at their home institutions, fluent in English, and nominated by a program coordinator from one of our Affiliated Institutions.

This is a wonderful opportunity for students, as it allows them to take upper division courses in the Department of Economics, interact with **world-renowned faculty**, and participate in a host of campus offerings one of the best public universities in the world.

Application Process

- Apply to BESAP through the home institution (open to new partners)
- Accepted students that need to complete the TOEFL test must do so by early-June for Fall semesters and by early-November for Spring semesters. The Economics department may also be able to waive the English Proficiency requirement.
- Each student will receive one invitation letter to International Student Services. A copy of this letter can be used for student loans, stipends, etc.
- Students submit an online application to the International Concurrent Enrollment Program at UC Berkeley, Extension.

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
