The teaching activity during this period will be via distance – online learning.

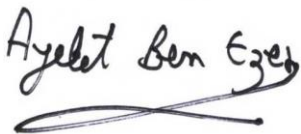
These regulations are in effect from tomorrow 17.9.2020 until 8.10.2020 and will, thereafter, be re-assessed.
