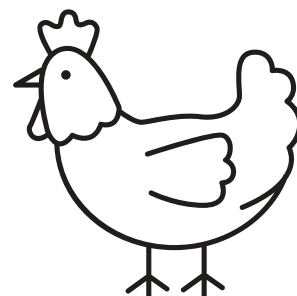

Our mission is to be a meeting point for people in Israel and Jewish communities abroad, offering engaging conversations on Israeli culture, music, current events, innovation, sustainability, and more. As part of an educational radio initiative, our station is completely free of advertising and commercial content.

Volunteer Tasks

- All our podcasts are **created, recorded, and edited by students**. This is a **challenging and demanding** volunteer placement that requires creativity, teamwork, and strong time management. **While no prior podcasting or radio experience is required**, you must be ready to learn quickly and meet deadlines. We will teach you everything you need to know — from planning your show, to recording, editing, and publishing — but we expect you to commit fully to the production process.
- **Upon registration, all volunteers will create 1 trial episode to ensure it's the right placement for both you and the station.**
- Volunteers who continue will commit to producing **10 episodes over the year** (two full semesters), with at least **4 episodes completed during the first semester**.
- Each episode will have a clear deadline. **Failure to meet deadlines will result in discontinuation from the radio program and the need to find an alternative volunteer placement.**

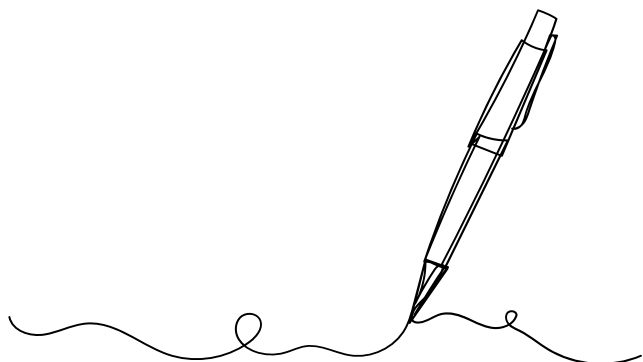

Is a Pre-Army Academy designed for future Lone Soldiers (Olim) interested in enlisting, primarily in combat roles. The academy is run entirely by volunteers, most of whom are ex-lone soldiers from elite units. The program operates solely on volunteers and donations, and it is free for lone soldiers to attend. Our mission is to share knowledge and experiences to help prepare future soldiers. Core activities include high-intensity physical conditioning (army preparation), one-on-one mentorship, guidance (lectures on the army, visits to bases), leadership, and teamwork training. Supported by Growing Wings, a nonprofit that provides funding to various programs that assist lone soldiers.

Trainers are required to attend sessions, typically held Friday mornings or Thursday evenings, depending on the season. Training sessions last 3 to 5 hours, making this position suitable for volunteers with availability to commit to longer hours.
