Course registration	In principle, Erasmus and exchange students may attend classes from all our programmes, subject to the usual limitations of classroom capacity and prerequisites.
Academic calendar	Fall semester: late August to mid-December Spring semester: start February to second half of May More detail: Academic Calendar
Teaching language / Language requirements	All classes are taught in English. Although we do not require a formal certificate, we recommend that all students should meet level B2 requirements for English language proficiency under CEFR.
Class load	Recommended minimum: 3 classes (18 ECTS), maximum: 5 classes (30 ECTS)
Art fee	Students should note that some Arts classes carry a small art fee to cover the cost of materials and/or museum and gallery entry (in the range 800 CZK – 2000 CZK = approx. 30 – 80 EUR). No tuition or other fees are payable.
Transcripts of Records	Transcripts of records will be sent by email to the home university after the end of exams.

Orientation and Arrival	Orientation programmes are offered both semesters, usually for 2-3 days in the week before the start of classes (dates vary)
Housing	Students may stay at the AAU dorm in Prague 7 or at one of the apartments on offer via a private housing provider. AAU Housing
Visas	Citizens of the EU and EFTA do not need a visa to study at AAU, but students of other nationalities will have to arrange a visa and/or a residence permit. Processing times can be up to 2 months or longer, so early applications are encouraged. AAU Visa Info
Health Insurance	AAU has no specific requirement regarding health insurance, but students are responsible for their own medical costs and insurance is recommended. Students who need a visa must meet the minimum requirements of the Czech immigration authorities. AAU Health Insurance
