We wish to emphasize that the Interdisciplinary Center Herzliya is prepared for any possible scenario for the return to studies.

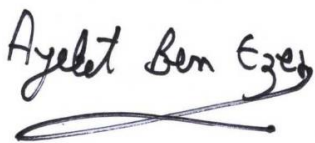
