

RRIS Need-Based Scholarships via the Financial Aid office of the RRIS

The Raphael Recanati International School at Reichman University provides scholarships to students in need.

Students encountering difficulty in covering their tuition should contact the RRIS Financial Aid office to explore scholarship options and/or loans at rris.financialaid@runi.ac.il.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. A student is eligible to receive a scholarship from the RRIS if he/she is a full-time student paying full tuition.
- 2. Scholarship applications for students residing in Israel for less than 5 years (not included Army service), will be available on the RRIS scholarship page at Reichman University's website.
- 3. Israeli citizens residing in Israel for more than five years cannot apply for this scholarship but may apply for a needs-based scholarship through the Dean of Students' office at gzvi@runi.ac.il.
- 4. Deadlines
 - a. The deadline for submitting the application form for the needs-based scholarship for continuing students at the RRIS is August 1.
 - Deadline for submitting the application form for the needs-based scholarship for new students is the last day of Orientation Week.
 - c. The application shall only be submitted to the Financial Aid office of the RRIS.
 Applications submitted through the Student Administration or through the Israeli scholarship department will not be accepted. Applications submitted late or lacking any of the required documents, will not be considered and shall be disqualified.
- 5. Information must be meticulously filled in and all details documented as required.
- 6. Students who pay a rent amount that exceeds the rent amount of the Reichman University Dorms are not eligible to apply for the scholarship application.
- 7. Continuing students having 3 failing grades on their grade sheet or that have a GPA below 60 will not be eligible to apply for a scholarship.
- 8. Students who have been found guilty of a disciplinary offense by the Disciplinary Committee are not eligible to apply for a scholarship.
- 9. The decision concerning the scholarship shall be given to the student 6-8 weeks after receipt of the complete scholarship application file if the student submits the application before August 1. If the application is submitted after that date, the decision will be given 8-12 weeks after receipt.



- 10. The total amount of scholarships a student is entitled to receive from the RRIS shall not exceed 75% of the tuition of that year (socio-economic, merit scholarship, etc.).
- 11. Students who receive any type of scholarship and terminate their studies or their studies are terminated for any reason whatsoever, will be obliged to return the sum of the scholarship provided. For this matter, freezing academic studies is considered termination of studies by the student.
- 12. Any student receiving a scholarship of any type from the RRIS shall be obliged to participate in the community involvement program (volunteering) in the scope and manner determined by the Scholarships Committee. Fulfillment of this stipulation is a fundamental requirement. Students who fail to fulfill this commitment will not be eligible to apply for a scholarship the following year. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to demand that the student returns the scholarship awarded. The required amount of volunteer hours for the RRIS need based scholarship is 30 hours.
- 13. Scholarship recipients are required to write one thank you letter to the donor per academic year and participate in donor events if necessary.
- 14. The Scholarship Regulations appear on the Reichman University's website.
