Salima Mustafa Suleiman is the Director of Economic Development at the Authority for Economic Development in the Minorities Sectors in The Prime Minister's Office since 2010 and in the Ministry of Social Equality since 2015.

Salima is responsible for forming and implementation of designated government decisions and programs for economic and social development of the minority population in Israel. Including managing contact with Arab local authorities, NGO's and Ministries.

Since 2016, she is responsible for implementing the Government Decision 922 in the Arab local authorities. Government Decision 922 is the Government Plan for Economic Development of the Arab Population for the years 2016-2020, and it includes 15 Ministries and a budget of around NIS 15 billion.
