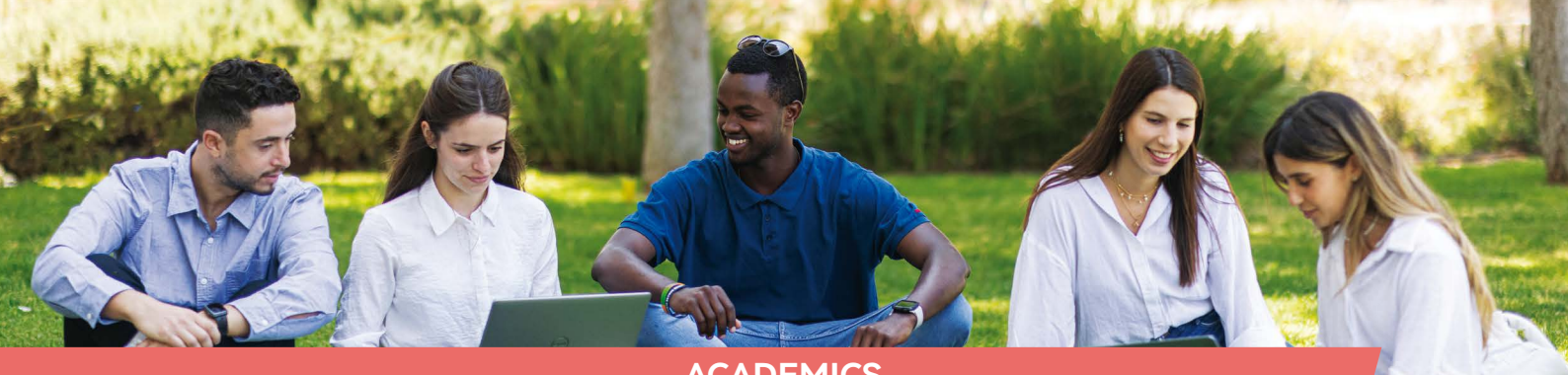

ACADEMICS

Q. What kinds of classes can students take?

A. As a Study Abroad student, you will be able to choose courses from the following Reichman University schools: Psychology, Government, Communications, and Business. Once you receive your acceptance letter, you will work with an academic advisor to build a tailor-made course schedule based on your interests and academic requirements.

Q. Are there restrictions on classes that students can take?

A. There are certain restrictions. Study Abroad students may not take: honors classes, skills workshops, Computer Science classes, or Entrepreneurship classes.

Q. How many classes do students take per semester?

A. Students can take as few or as many classes as they choose.

Q. Can students receive credits for the classes they take?

A. Yes. Reichman University is a recognized academic institution all over the world, and our coursework can count towards your major, minor, and electives at your home institution. However, we still advise students to check with their home college or university as to whether they accept Reichman University credits.

SOCIAL

Q. Are there social opportunities and/or trips for the students?

A. RRIS organizes a wide variety of social and cultural activities for all the students on campus, including Study Abroad students. Throughout the academic year, the school hosts cultural events, performances, film screenings, educational tours, meetings, social gatherings, and more. Study Abroad students are invited to participate in events organized by the Reichman University Student Union and the OU-JLIC (Orthodox Union Jewish Learning Initiative on Campus). There is an Orientation Week before classes begin, which offers students an opportunity to meet other RRIS students and get acculturated to Reichman University and Israel.

Q. What kind of supervision is provided for students?

A. Study Abroad students, as well as all first-year RRIS students, are given a peer counselor. Peer counselors are second or third year students, bilingual in both English and Hebrew, who have experience in youth movements, camps, and youth guidance and training. Peer counselors are responsible for contacting incoming students before the school year begins, as well as maintaining communication and offering guidance throughout the year. There are also psychologists on campus, as well as a Career Center and writing center to help students with their specific needs.

HOUSING & TUITION

Q. Do the students live in dorms or apartments?

A. Students have the option of living in our on-campus dorms. They consist of single-room suites with a bed, closet, bathroom, kitchenette, and table/chairs. The dorms include study halls and communal social areas to enable students to focus on their studies and maintain a varied social life. Each building has laundry rooms with washing machines and dryers at the residents' disposal, a Shabbat elevator, and a prayer room. The dorms are maintained by skilled, experienced professional staff who are at the students' service on a daily basis.

Q. How much does the Study Abroad program cost? Does the cost include dorms?

A. The Study Abroad program is \$12,000 USD per semester or \$24,000 USD per year. The tuition fee does not include dorms or health insurance.

Q. How much do the dorms cost? What is included?

A. Dorms are \$950 USD per month. The cost includes Wi-Fi, building fees, maintenance, and security. It does not include electricity or water.

Q. How much does health insurance cost?

A. Health insurance is \$800 USD each semester.
