THE ARGOV FELLOWS PROGRAM IN LEADERSHIP AND DIPLOMACY Building on the legacy of former Israeli Ambassador Shlomo Argov z”l, the Argov Fellows Program acts as a leadership accelerator to prepare exceptional students from all Reichman University schools for future leadership positions in a wide range of fields, both in Israel and overseas. The program accepts around 20 students from all RU degree programs who are in their final year of studies. (It is also possible to participate in the program during the year following the completion of the bachelor's degree). Through a challenging interdisciplinary curriculum, the Argov program strives to give students the knowledge, tools, and skills necessary to meet the many challenges that Israel faces in today's complex global environment. Conducted entirely in English, it combines academic training, practical skills workshops, extensive experiential learning . The program's unique curriculum includes courses, seminars, and workshops taught exclusively to Argov Fellows by leading academic and professional experts from Israel and around the world. Students also participate in study tours to Europe, the United States, Taiwan, and throughout Israel. The fellowship year concludes with a public presentation of capstone group policy projects, in which the fellows propose their solutions to major policy challenges facing Israel and the Jewish people. Upon graduation, fellows become members of the Argov Alumni Association. To date, there are close to 400 Argov alumni. Many of the program's graduates have continued on to prestigious fellowship programs (such as Rhodes and Chevening), graduate programs at leading universities(including Harvard, Columbia, Cambridge and Oxford), and key positions in the public, private, and nonprofit sectors all over the world. www.runi.ac.il/argov
